Peak Flow - Normal Values

These sounds are transmitted along the trachea and bronchi and filtered through normal lungs to the chest wall (Talley and O'Connor, 2001). Volume and frequency of breath sounds are changed by pathology of the lungs and surrounding tissues, generating clinical signs (Ford et al, 2005).
